WorkKeys Assessments

WorkKeys is a job skills assessment system that helps employers select, hire, train, develop and retain a high-performance workforce.

- Each test **Graphic Literacy, Applied Math** and **Workplace Documents** is timed at 55 minutes.
 - In order to complete your application with Local 375 Plumbers & Pipefitters, you must score a **Level 6 or higher on Applied Math** and a **Level 4 or higher** on Graphic Literacy and Workplace Documents.
- <u>Practice prior to taking the WorkKeys assessment is strongly encouraged.</u> Please ask a Job Center representative for a username and password for the online tutorial WorkKeys Curriculum. You can practice on any computer that has Internet.

Tests are offered at 1PM on Mondays and 9AM on Wednesdays at the Fairbanks Job Center.

You must register ahead of time in order to test.
